Below you will see detailed instructions on how to use the Fleetwide/Fuelman and CFN site locator.

1. Go to your internet browser (ex. Internet Explorer)
2. Type the following web address and press the Enter Key after typing
<http://www.cfnnet.com/>
3. With your mouse put the cursor on top of **“Site Locator”** and click on it.
4. The software will ask you to select a card product: CFN or **FleetWide**? Select **FleetWide**.
5. Now you will have three tabs to use (each works differently):
 - a. **Site Listing Maps**
 - i. Start by selecting a State in the USA.
 - ii. The “search by” field will darken and you will be able to select three different options: Metro, County, or City.
 - iii. Enter the zip code.
 - iv. If desired, you can sort out the types of Fuels, and Features & Services by clicking on “Show” and selecting.
 - v. You can display the report on your monitor, or the data can be downloaded to Excel in a spreadsheet.
 - b. **Nearby Sites**
 - i. Type an address, and the software will do a search in a 5 to 25 mile radius, depending on your selection; and it will show you all the fuel sites in the surrounding area of the address that you typed in.
 - ii. If desired, you can sort out the types of Fuels, and Features & Services by clicking on “Show” and selecting.
 - c. **Driving Directions**
 - i. Type the “Origin Address”
 - ii. Type the “Destination Address”
 - iii. You can choose to avoid: Major Highways, Toll Roads, and Ferry Lanes.
 - iv. You can increase the radius from 0.5 miles to 15 miles.
 - v. The software works similar to mapquest, it will give you directions on how to get to your destination; however, including the Fleetwide/Fuelman locations along the way.
